Dear Friends,

As human beings we quite often get the wrong end of the stick about things. It is usually accidental, but because something is not quite what we expect, we misunderstand completely.

The Easter stories are full of people getting the wrong end of the stick. Mary thinks Jesus' body has been stolen. Peter sees the linen wrappings and can't work out what it's all about.

The disciples didn't understand the scriptures. The angels question Mary and she still doesn't know what's going on. Then she thinks Jesus is the gardener. Then, it seems, she reaches out to cling on to him, and he tells her she mustn't. You could hardly get more misunderstandings into a couple of paragraphs if you tried.

The point is, of course: Easter has burst into their world, the world of space, time and matter, the world of real history and real people and real life, but their minds and imaginations were unable to contain it, so they did their best to put the ocean into a bottle and fit the explosive fact of the resurrection into the possibilities they already knew about.

I think this is all rather comforting for us. Sometimes we get a sense that there is more to life than the here and now, there is a depth to existence that cannot be measured by scientific instruments, a spiritual dimension, just as real, but rather more elusive than the other dimensions. The confusion in the Easter story reminds us that we are not alone if we don't understand it, but the message of Easter is that we are also not alone if we decide to explore it.

Claire and Mike Tomes Canoe Challenge

Over the Easter weekend we will be canoeing 125 miles from Devizes in Wiltshire to Westminster. We are using an 18 foot canoe which we will have to portage around the 77 locks. A portage is where we have to get out of our canoe and run/walk around a canal lock, then jump back in the canoe the other side and carry on canoeing. We have been training since December in snow and -8° temperatures, mainly in the dark on Coniston and Windermere waters.

Two years ago our son Arran, aged 4, started his treatment for Non-Hodgkin Lymphoma at Manchester Children's Hospital for almost a year. He is one of the lucky ones and his survival is all down to successful research that came up with his treatment plan, but more research is needed to save more lives.

COMMUNITY SNOW PLOUGH / GRITTING

Living in a rural area we face adverse winter driving conditions. This winter has been no exception. This causes accidents and travel delays. The prospect of being snowed in may seem attractive, if one has a full larder. The novelty wears off. But what of day to day issues and the risks that go with travel? The greatest risk is that those in need of any urgent medical care may be denied it in sufficient time to avoid loss of life or other damaging consequences:

Inability to travel to/from work may cause loss of income.

School or college attendance can be disrupted.

Tourist trade can be disrupted.

Restaurant and pub trades are hard hit.

We, as a community, have the ability to change things for the better. A small group initiated a project to obtain a gritter and snow plough to deliver a service to roads that get little or no Council attention. This project is close to achieving that objective. A tractor together with a driver is in place. Equipment is being ordered. Approvals from the Council and Highways departments have been obtained. Supply and storage of Rock Salt / Grit has been arranged. Hawkshead Parish Council now manage the project. We have secured grants as well as significant donations from people in our community. But we need more to ensure viability of this service. If you can make a donation, large or small, the Parish Council will be grateful.
