Do you need a lift?

Perhaps you have an appointment
at hospital and getting there is
awkward, or you don't have

From Auschwitz to Ambleside and the Flying Boats of Windermere- Tuesday 17th July, 2pm onwards

A talk by Trevor Avery BEM, Director of the Lake District Holocaust Project at the permanent exhibition

Exhibition on loan from Yad Vashem

Followed by a guided tour of the Calgarth Estate, the location where three hundred child survivors of the Holocaust stayed when they arrived in the Lake District during the summer of 1945.

The tour will provide insight into the estate's amazing history on the shore of Windermere.

Starting at 2pm, the exhibition is located at Windermere Library, Ellerthwaite, Windermere LA23 2AJ.

You are advised to ensure you have received your ticket confirmation before making any travel arrangements. Access to a car is essential for the visit to the site of the former Calgarth Estate.

A pay and display car park is located next to Windermere Library and parking is available at the Calgarth Estate site.

Following this visit, as part of the Hawkshead Summer Music Festival there is a Klezmer Concert in St Michaels & All Angels Church, Hawkshead at 8pm.

TOWER PROJECT

The tower is now covered in scaffolding (as many Link readers will have noticed) and work on the masonry is well underway. Chipping out the cement mortar pointing is proving hard work, and hence the use of (rather noisy) electric hammers – so please bear with us. But its importance has quickly become clear: even close to the top of the tower, the old lime mortar (“trapped” behind the newer cement work) is quite clearly damp. It will be damper still as we get closer to the base of the tower.

As each section is cleared of the old ribbon-pointing, it is being cleaned up and repointed flush with “breathable” lime mortar. Some finished sections are already visible at the top of the tower and the new work looks fantastic.

By the time you read this, the rebuilding of the parapets and finials on top of a new water-tight lead tray should be well-advanced, together with the re-slating of the roof. The clock faces and hands have been removed and

will be refurbished and restored once the masonry work is complete. The bell mechanisms have been wrapped up to keep out the dust and grit, and the ringing-frame protected with a large tarpaulin. So, no bell-ringing or clock chimes for as long as the work is raising dust.

We are still a bit short of raising sufficient funding to cover the total cost. Please contribute generously to events in support of the Tower Appeal as they occur.
