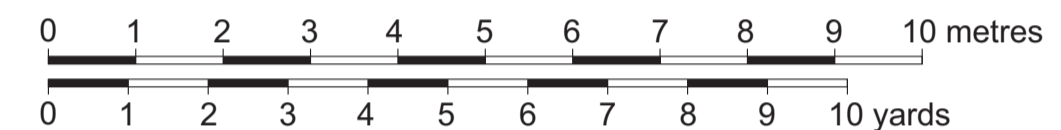


PLAN OF RUSLAND CHURCHYARD

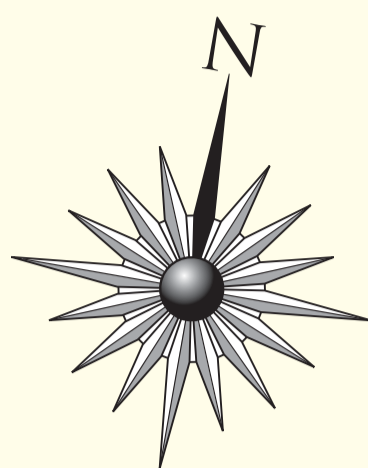
