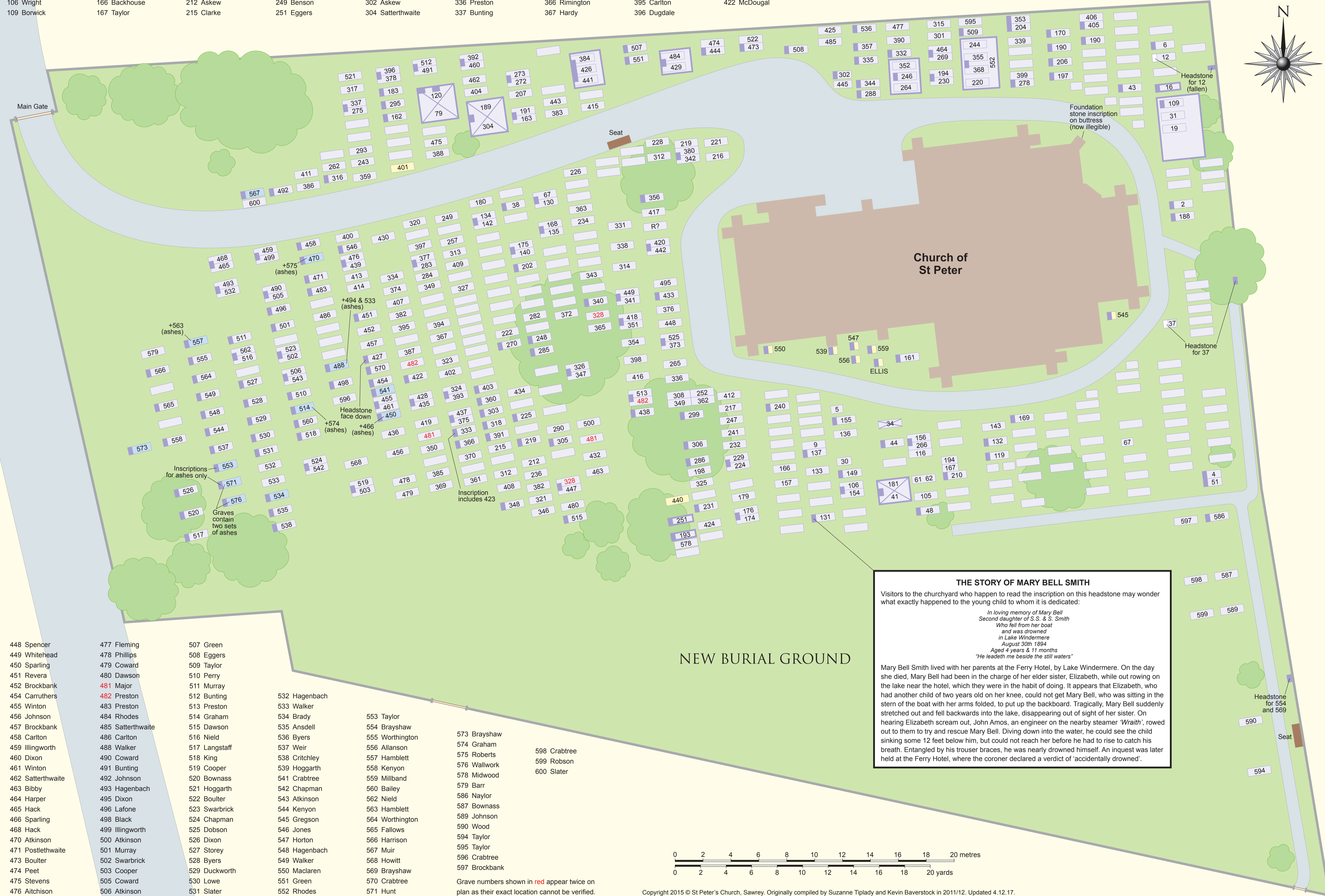

**THE STORY OF MARY BELL SMITH**

Visitors to the churchyard who happen to read the inscription on this headstone may wonder what exactly happened to the young child to whom it is dedicated:

*In loving memory of Mary Bell  
Second daughter of S.S. & S. Smith  
Who fell from her boat  
and was drowned  
in Lake Windermere  
August 30th 1894  
Aged 4 years & 11 months  
"He leadeth me beside the still waters"*

Mary Bell Smith lived with her parents at the Ferry Hotel, by Lake Windermere. On the day she died, Mary Bell had been in the charge of her elder sister, Elizabeth, while out rowing on the lake near the hotel, which they were in the habit of doing. It appears that Elizabeth, who had another child of two years old on her knee, could not get Mary Bell, who was sitting in the stern of the boat with her arms folded, to put up the backboard. Tragically, Mary Bell suddenly stretched out and fell backwards into the lake, disappearing out of sight of her sister. On hearing Elizabeth scream out, John Amos, an engineer on the nearby steamer 'Wraith', rowed out to them to try and rescue Mary Bell. Diving down into the water, he could see the child sinking some 12 feet below him, but could not reach her before he had to rise to catch his breath. Entangled by his trouser braces, he was nearly drowned himself. An inquest was later held at the Ferry Hotel, where the coroner declared a verdict of 'accidentally drowned'.
